MYFFA events are learning experiences for athletes. Watching a game is a privilege. The idea is to observe a friendly game, not to verbally assault others or be obnoxious. Audiences may forget that athletes have not reached mature physical performance, so mistakes are expected.

- Please remember that you are here to support not only your team but to support all participants of the game.
- Learning the rules of the game would be beneficial and would make it a more enjoyable experience for you as a fan.
- Show respect for the opposing players, coaches, and fans at all times.
- Refrain from taunting or making any kind of derogatory remarks to your opponents and officials during and after the game.
- Respect the referees and appreciate their willingness to participate in the game.
- Recognize and show appreciation for an outstanding play by either team.
- The use of any controlled substances (alcohol, drugs, etc.) before, during and after games on or near the site of the event is ***strictly prohibited***.
 - Smoking on the field is prohibited
 - No pets are allowed on the field at any time. Please relay this to your guests.
 - Please be respectful and pick up all trash when you leave.
 - Concealed weapons are prohibited...Permit or not.
- Be a positive behavior role model through your own actions and by censuring those around you at games where behavior is unbecoming.
